One night Ezekiel had a strange dream.

He dreamed he was taken to the middle of a large valley full of old, dry bones.

God asked Ezekiel, "Can these bones live?" Ezekiel answered, "I don't know, Lord. Only You know that!" Ezekiel watched as the dry bones stood up and became an living, powerful army.

Then God explained the dream. "My people are sad. They think things will not get better. Tell them that things will get better. They will return to the Promised Land."

Ezekiel told the people what God said. "Dry bones can live. **All things are possible with God!**"

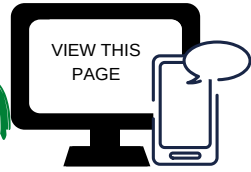

This series special will give you interesting ways to remember what to pray for as we "pray to the LORD for" the peace of our city and those around us.

This type of prayer is intercession prayer.

With this type of prayer we are reaching out to God and asking Him to act in the lives of people, so that they will be able to see and enjoy His Kingdom



LEGO PRAYER

**Each person choose a lego brick:
Hold your brick.**

Pray for yourself.

Thank God for the things he has given you.
Ask God to help you to make new friends in your neighborhood.

Count the bumps on your brick.

For each bump on your brick, pray for a different person - friends or family members.

Ask God to give them joy and peace this week.

Find a different colour brick than the one you had. Hold them side by side.

Thank God for making each person special.
Thank Him for the things that are different but special about other people.

Ask God to help you and others to learn how to celebrate and understand people who are different from us.

Find another brick with the same number of bumps as your original brick.

Thank God for families and friends, front line workers and all who care for us. **ASK GOD** that He will help us to be friends to those who are lonely.

Swap your brick for another one which someone in your family is holding.

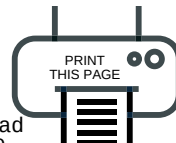
Thank God for the person you swapped with and **ask God** to bless them this week. List some blessing you would like God to give them

Put 10 bricks together and build a structure or tower with them.

Thank God for the church and the communities we live in.
ASK GOD that He will help us to include others and to help people know that they are loved and valued.
