


Vhat to do! WHAT YOU NEED:

any type of paper (of any colour) you have on hand. some scissors, something to write with some glue or tape.

To prepare for the activity cut strips of paper that are big enough to write on. We will be using strips of paper next week as well so hold on to any extra pieces.


How to make a paper chain:

Once you have written your prayer on the strip of paper, form it into a loop so that the prayer is on the outside. Tape or glue it closed. Whe you have a second prayer strip to attach, first loop it onto the first/previous loop and then glue/ tape the loop. Continue on to create your very own paper prayer chain!

NOW sit with your hand like the ones below.


Now say the first three lines 3 or 4 of 5 times slowly and guietly.


