As a family, sit down together: answer the following questions:



- List the things that we know about Zacchaeus.
- Zacchaeus was Jewish. He collected taxes for the Romans who were their enemies. He cheated the people and became wealthy while they became poorer. How do you think his neighbors felt about him?
- Why do you think Jesus noticed Zacchaeus and wanted to go to his house?
- Think about the things that the Bible doesn't say. Talk about what might have happened between verses 7 and 8.
- Zacchaeus was greedy, selfish, and a cheat. What changed in Zacchaeus? Make a list of things that described Zacchaeus after he met with Jesus.
- After Zacchaeus met Jesus, how did his perspective of his neighbors change?

- We want to have a fresh perspective on the people in our neighborhood as God opens our eyes to what he wants us to see.
- Go for a walk in your neighborhood, asking God to point out people who need your prayers. Then ask Him to show you what He is doing there.
