

10 MINUTES

As a family, sit down together: after reading the Bible passage above discuss the following:

- How does Luke describe Zechariah and Elizabeth? (v.5,6)
- Count how many times you read 'do not be afraid' in the passage. What is another way of saying that?
- How did God give peace to Elizabeth? (v. 41)
- What did God say to Zechariah that gave him peace? (v.13-16)
- What did the angel tell Mary that gave her comfort and peace? (v. 30-37)
- Jesus came to bring us His peace which is whole and pure. Talk as a family about what troubles you. Pray together to ask Jesus for His guidance and His peace in your situation(s)

Advent is a time of anticipation, waiting for something to come. As we wait for Christmas to come, we can keep Jesus as our focus:


- Worship Jesus and share joy with others.
