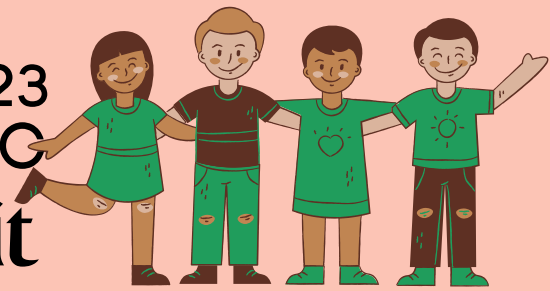

- List 4 ways Johnathan and David were good friends for each other.

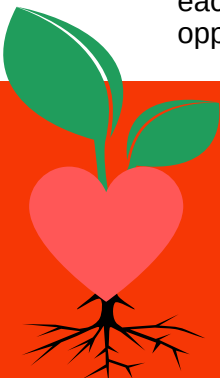
