As a family, sit down together: after reading the Bible passage above discuss the following: In the Blble story, what was broken? What did Ezra want to build? Why was that important? Ezra wanted to rebuild the Temple like it WAS before they were exiled. This can be good and bad. Talk about why it is good to do things like they were done before. For Parents: • Ezra wanted to teach the people what the scriptures said so that they could have a better future. Talk about how it is good to make changes and do things differently Who in your family likes change, and who doesn't? Why? Ask each other how you can help when things are hard.
