As a counsellor, you'll model engagement, enthusiasm, cooperation and relationship. You'll also:

- \cdot Supervise and coordinate the efforts of one or two LiTs assigned to your group each week.
- \cdot Participate in training, debriefs and counsellor meetings to help the camp team forge a positive and energetic environment for the whole group.

 \cdot Follow the lead of the Senior and Associate Day Camp Directors and support them by filling in wherever is needed.
