



SUMMER DAY CAMP

L.I.T. DIRECTOR

Looking for a great leadership and learning opportunity? Want to do something that makes a lasting impact in the lives of some kids? This is a 35 hr/wk, Monday-Friday position lasting from May 26 – August 19, 2025. The successful candidate will work closely with our Senior Day Camp Director to ensure the success of our 4 week summer Day Camp program, with a specific focus on developing and managing our Leaders in Training (LiT) program.

What You'll Do:

As LiT Director, you'll hire, train, support, organize, and evaluate the volunteer youth who assist in our four weeks of Day Camp in July and August. That means you'll:

- Manage a team of 8-10 youth volunteers (LiTs) per week- 25-30 total - who will be assisting the camp counselors as they care for our campers. This involves team-building, communicating, scheduling, training, supporting and evaluating.
- Create and lead a well-organized leadership development program that will include youth with diverse backgrounds from the community and church family. You will also create and implement a feedback/evaluation process for your team.
- Train youth volunteers (LiTs), in conjunction with the Senior Day Camp Director, to provide safe and proper care and programming for the children. You'll create and implement a quality, week-long leadership training schedule for the LiTs with goals and objectives.
- A portion of your time (25-50%) will be devoted to assisting the Senior Day Camp Director in planning and administering the Day Camp Program itself.
- Work with adult volunteers to help support the camp program as well as liaise with the various coordinators of those teams.
- Sub in for the Senior Day Camp Director in case they need to be absent for a time or from the facility.
- Do other stuff we might think up at the time.

What You'll Bring:

- Your faith. We're looking for someone who is a follower of Jesus whose life reflects the teaching, values and love of Jesus for all people.
- Your maturity. You need to be between the ages of 18-30 years and have a love for children and youth.
- Your servant heart. This is a senior leadership role where success is mostly defined by helping others develop. You have to be in it for them.
- Your skills. You need good administrative and relational skills and you need to be able to multi-task.
- Your commitment. We need you to be available to work full-time for the entire contract period.
- Your sense of humour. (We're into fun around here!)
