A voice of one calling: “In the wilderness prepare the way for the Lord; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain. And the glory of the Lord will be revealed, and all people will see it together. For the mouth of the Lord has spoken.”

Pray for the **candidates** running in your local riding for in the federal election on April 28.

Pray for the **needs** in your local area– what are people most anxious/concerned about?

** If you're not sure who or what these are, take some time to research, listening for how God prompts you to pray throughout.*

Pray for those who are/will be being most effected by the **uncertainty in our economy** (job loss, retirees, etc.)

Pray for decisions being made by **our government** about how to weather the current storm being caused by the trade war.

Pray for **peace** between nations – that tensions do not escalate further.

Pray that Jesus-followers would rise to the occasion as God’s people of **peace, compassion and reconciliation.**
